

Interview My Mom's Family






1. How did you choose my name?

My parents chose my name by looking in a book of Jewish baby names under the letter m.






2. Who was I named after?

I was named after my paternal great-grandfather, Morris, and my maternal great-grandfather, Marvin.






3. Do I have a Hebrew name that is different from my English name?

- b) Do you still have family that lives there?My mom is not aware of any family members still living




5. Does our family consider ourselves / follow the traditions of the Ashkenazim, Sephardim, Mizrahim?

I'm named after two family members that have passed away in their honor, we say, "Good Shabbos" with an s versus t, and we speak yiddish (Kepala,Punim.)






How did we end up in Canada?

Interview (My Dad's Family)




1. Where are your family members from?

My dad's family members are from Russia and Austria-Hungary.


a) Has anyone in your family returned or visited there? My dad is not aware of any family members going back to Russia and Austria-Hungary.






b) Do you still have family that lives there? My dad is not aware of any family members that still live in Russia and Austria-Hungary.





The Meaning of my Name






What does Maytal mean?






The Given Name Maytal

Maytal is also spelled like Meital. Embraced by many parents, the name Maytal, is one of warmth and brilliance. It is a wonderfully distinctive name.






How it Relates To Me
