WHAT ARE THE LAWS FOR TU BISHVAT?

PUBLIC FAST DAYS SHOULD NOT BE PROCLAIMED ON TU BISHVAT. THE- MINHAG IS TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF TREE FRUITS ONE USUALLY EATS ON TU B'SHEVAT. SOME HAVE THE CUSTOM TO HAVE A SEDER OF EATING FRUITS ON TU BISHVAT. SOME HAVE THE MINHAG TO EAT CAROB ON TU BISHVAT. THE CUSTOM OF EATING FRUITS, LIKE APPLIES. SOME PEOPLE HAVE THE CUSTOM OF EATING A SPECIAL SEUDAH ON TU B'SHEVAT. THERE IS A MINHAG TO EAT ETROG JAM ON TU B'SHVAT. YOU CAN FIND THIS IN TERUMOT AND MAASROT.



TRADITIONS IN ISRAEL VS HE REST OF THE WORLD?

<u>CANADA</u>: Many Jewish communities in Canada observe Tu B'Shevat by Eating Fruit on this day. The Torah praises seven "food", in particular grapes, figs, pomegranates, olives and dates. Many Jewish people also try to eat a new fruit, which can be any seasonal fruit. Some Jewish communities plant trees on Tu B'Shevat.

ISRAEL: JEWS EAT PLENTY OF FRUIT ON TU B'SHEVAT, PARTICULARLY THE KINDS ASSOCIATED WITH ISRAEL. THE TORAH PRAISES SEVEN 'FOOD' IN PARTICULAR: WHEAT, BARLEY, GRAPES, FIGS, POMEGRANATES, OLIVES AND DATES. ... A SPECIAL, LONGER BLESSING IS RECITED FOR THE FRUITS MENTIONED IN THE TORAH.

WHAT ARE THE ADDITIONS IN THE BIRKAT HAMAZON AND T'FILAH? IS THERE A SPECIAL SHABBAT BEFORE OR AFTER? WHAT SPECIAL BLESSING DO WE RECITE?
